Children like Noah, who was entered into the Children's Shelter with his two brothers after his father became homeless. Noah had severe mood swings and was behind his peers in school. After receiving counseling and tutoring sessions, he is now excelling in class, has improved his bond with his father and recently competed in a karate competition. He is in the final stage of being placed with a Foster family.

Families like Emilio's, who had hardship from job loss, family crisis and balancing the needs of three children. Upon enrolling in FACES Early Head Start, Emilio's self-esteem and attitude toward his parents and siblings improved dramatically. With help from FACES, his mother received resources to find employment and is now continuing her education.
